

# Mama's Kitchen Magnet

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## Surface & Supplies:

Wood Cutout  
Basic Painting Supplies  
Button or Strip Magnet  
Craft Glue  
Krylon 1311 Matte Finish

## Americana Paint:

Antique Rose	Blue Haze Light
Dark Chocolate	Green Tea
Hauser Medium Green	Honey Brown
Lamp Black	Light Buttermilk
Light Mocha	

## Loew Cornell Golden Taklon Brushes:

#4, #10 Shaders	10/0, 18/0 Liner
#1 Round	1/4", 3/8" Angular Shaders

1/8" Stencil Brush (1136)    1/4" Maxine's Mop (270)



*Transfer the main outlines, then transfer the pattern details as needed.*

## Let's Paint!

Basecoat the cup with Green Tea.

Basecoat the ginger's face and hands with Honey Brown.

Basecoat the icing on the ginger and the stripe on the cup with Light Mocha.

Using Antique Rose, drybrush the cheeks and paint the nose.

Use a stylus to dot the eyes, and then paint the lashes and mouth with the 18/0 liner brush and Lamp Black. Thin the paint with water to add the lashes and mouth.

Mix a drop of Honey Brown with a drop of Light Mocha to highlight the tops of the hands.

Using Dark Chocolate:

Shade the ginger's head and hands.

Shade just below the icing on the head and hands.

Shade the bottom edge of the ginger's nose.

Using Light Buttermilk:

Highlight the eyes and add the dots.

Highlight the top of the nose.

Make small back-to-back floats in the centers of the higher arched areas of the icing.

Shade the cup with Hauser Medium Green. Also shade just below the hands and just below the Light Mocha stripe on the cup.

Use the 10/0 liner with Blue Haze Light to paint the letters.

Lightly spray the front and sides of the project with Krylon. Glue the magnet on the back. Enjoy!

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
